The painting's purpose is to commemorate the significance of Musgrave Park to our people. All mob, whether local or visiting, have memories of corroboree, gathering, family and laughter, whilst honouring our ancestors' struggles in mourning. Musgrave represents staunch political activism of our Brisbane Blacks and has provided shelter and safety for our loved ones.

The artwork has a young warrior dancing. He feels the spirit of his people and ancestors wrapped around his feet, giving him strength to express himself freely and with pride. This is rooted in the connection he has with his totems.

Kuril (water rat) represents the South Brisbane region, which is traditionally a women's place for ceremony and healing. Bilin (peewee/magpie lark) is the totem of Grandfather Bilin who was the headman of the Yerongpan clan of the Yuggera Language Group.

Leeches have always had



significant healing properties for our people, which is recognised as the suburb Indooroopilly (Gully of the Leeches).

Finally, the three important symbols of our family's connections to the Country are surrounded by water-lilies', to honour the history of Spring Hill and Miguntyun (Brisbane). The springs would lead down to water holes where the Mothers would birth and raise their kin until the Kippas (young men) would leave for higher ground.

Behind the young warrior are symbols for gathering places/

campfires to represent the annual marches and protests from Miguntyun to Musgrave Park. Our people have always used protest as a means to get our voices heard, loud and proud!

Over 30 years of NAIDOC at Musgrave Park is a testament to our strength and spirit.
